

Reintegration Cash Support

If your application for asylum has been rejected or if you have withdrawn your application for asylum, and if you want to return voluntarily to your country of origin, you can apply for reintegration cash support. Migrationsverket will decide whether or not you are eligible to receive support. IOM pays out the reintegration cash support to eligible returnees in the countries of origin that Migrationsverket has previously decided on.

The reintegration cash support is equivalent to SEK 30,000 for each person over the age of 18 years and SEK15,000 for minors under the age of 18 years. A family can receive a maximum of SEK 75,000.

Cash payments are made by local IOM missions in the countries of origin.

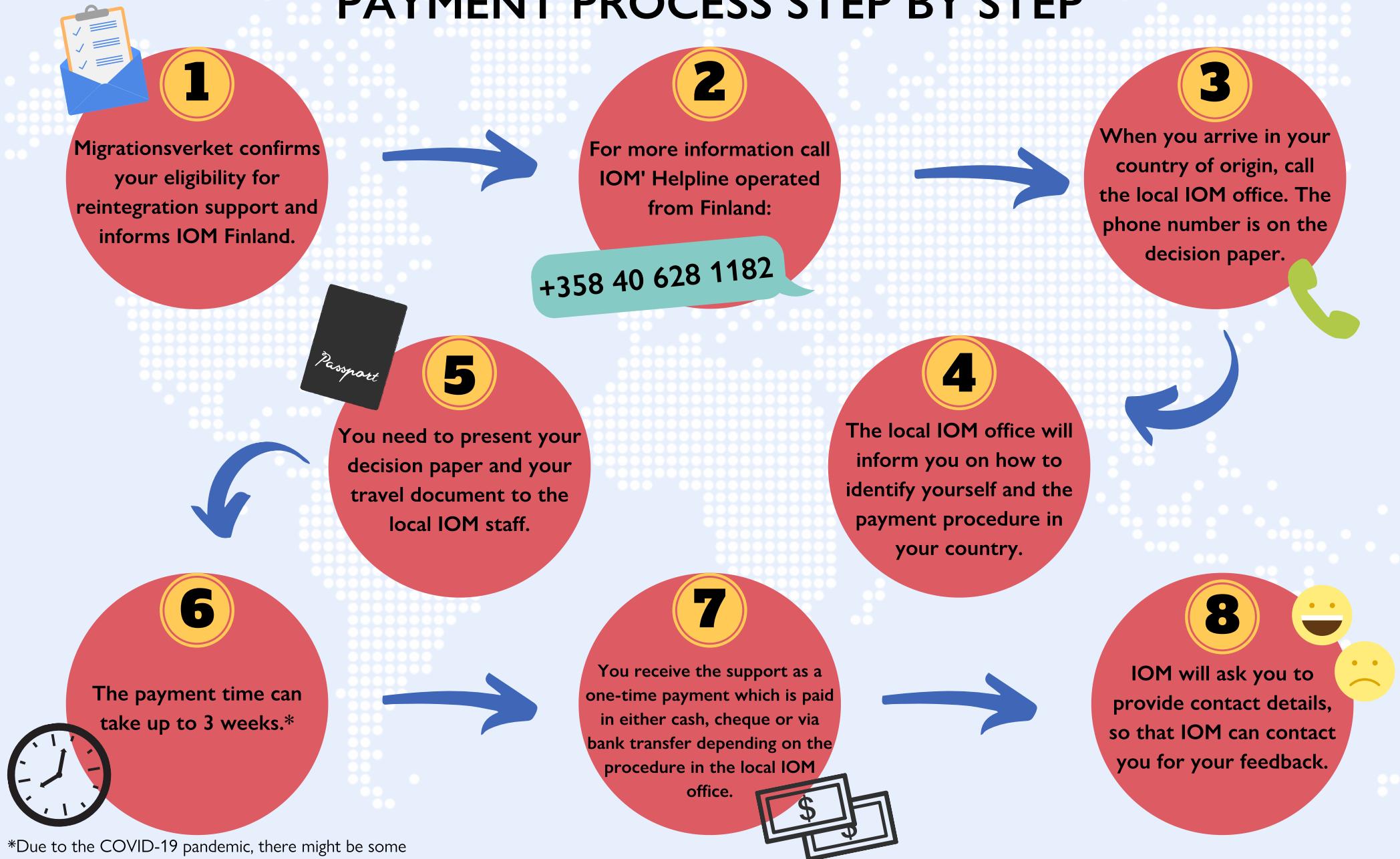
