

## Application for a certificate for a British frontier worker

If you are a British citizen residing in another country who is employed or self-employed in Sweden, this form is to be used to apply for a certificate that you are a frontier worker.

If all the information in the application is completed in full and all necessary documents are enclosed, your waiting time will be shorter. Do not forget to sign the form.

If the Swedish Migration Agency grants your application, you will receive a card as evidence of your rights as a frontier worker in Sweden.

**Employed in Sweden**

Enclose copies of the following documents:

- passport or British national identity card
- certificate of employment. If the certificate of employment is more than three months old, a payslip for the most recent month also needs to be attached. The certificate of employment must include the following information:
  - employer's name and contact information (address and telephone number)
  - employer's corporate registration number
  - wages
  - duration of the employment (permanent or temporary employment)
  - scope of the work, number of hours per week
  - when the employment began.
- document that shows that you are a resident of another country, such as a transcript from that country's civil/national registration.

**Self-employed in Sweden**

Enclose copies of the following documents:

- passport or British national identity card
- documents that show that you are self-employed, for example
  - F-tax certificate and certificate of registration for the company
  - latest VAT return submitted to the Swedish Tax Agency or an extract from the tax account
  - evidence that you are running a business, e.g. customer invoices, receipts for purchased materials, rental agreement for commercial premises, etc.

If you are in the process of setting up your own business in Sweden but do not yet have a business, you need to enclose copies of:

- documents which state the plans that are in place for the company and the preparations that have been made
- service contracts, customer contact information or a rental agreement for commercial premises
- transfer agreement and the most recent annual report.
- document that shows that you are a resident of another country, such as a transcript from that country's civil/national registration.

**5. Power of attorney**

If you would like a third party (a legal representative) to be able to represent you in your case, you must submit power of attorney form number 107011.

**6. Signature**

I confirm that the information I have provided in my application documents are correct, and that I have not omitted any information which may be of significant importance in the assessment of my case. I am aware that it is a criminal offence to submit incorrect information or to knowingly omit information that may be of significant importance in the assessment of my case.
