For your first application, you will generally have to apply for and be granted a permit before travelling to Sweden.

If you provide all the information in your form and include all the required documents, you will receive a decision sooner than if we have to ask you for supplementary information.

<p>All children with the ability and desire to do so have the right to speak and be heard regarding their case at the Swedish Migration Agency. Children may express their views themselves or have a representative do so, such as a parent, custodian or guardian. The child and his/her custodians (parents) will come to a decision on whether the child wants to be heard, and if so, how.</p> <p>If the child wants to express his/her views orally, he or she will be contacted by telephone or called to an interview with the Swedish Migration Agency or Swedish mission abroad. If the child's parents are interviewed orally, the child will also be interviewed orally. The child has the right to have an adult present at the interview, such as a parent, another custodian, a guardian and/or a public counsel. If the child wants to express his/her views in writing, it can be done in this application.</p> <p>It is important that it is the child's views being expressed, and not those of the adult.</p>

Documents that you are to send with your application

- Copies of your passport that shows your identity, the passport's period of validity and any residence permits for countries outside your home country.
- Receipt showing that you have paid your application fee (when applying from Sweden).
- Marriage certificate/document that shows that you have been living together.
- Birth certificate (for co-applicants who are children).
- Consent from custodian stating that the child/children is/are allowed to move to Sweden. (If the other custodian is not moving to Sweden). The consent must state the period of time that the child/children may live in Sweden. In order to prove that the right person has signed the consent, send, for example, a copy of his or her passport or other ID document.
- A letter from the person (husband, wife, registered partner, cohabiting partner, parent of child/children) in Sweden in which he or she confirms that you are to live together in Sweden. (Not required if you are applying together).
