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If you have been granted a declaration of refugee status or a refugee status declaration, you can get a travel document in accordance with the 1951 Geneva Convention. If you are stateless, you can get a travel document in accordance with the 1954 New York Convention.

You must submit the application for a travel document in person at one of the Swedish Migration Agency's Service Centres. Remember that everybody applying for a travel document must come in person, including children. There is no fee for this application but an administrative surcharge of SEK 350 applies when you collect the travel document.

- valid identification
- any previous travel document.

Consent for the Swedish Migration Agency to issue a travel document for a child under the age of 18

As parent (guardian), you must fill in this section when you apply for a travel document for a child under the age of 18. Normally, one or both of the child's parents are guardians, but that role may be given to a trustee or a specially appointed legal guardian.

Note that if there are two guardians, both must approve that the Swedish Migration Agency issues a travel document for the child. If one of the guardians is staying in another country, her or his consent must nonetheless be provided to the Swedish Migration Agency.
