You must also attach a special Hosting Agreement signed by both yourself and the research organisation (institute, organisation, company, etc.) where you will be working in order to work as a visiting researcher in Sweden for a period exceeding three months. Note: There are special forms for EU/EEA nationals and nationals from Switzerland and their relatives.
